

Directions for installing NHL Style netting

Terms:

Selvage - A single netting square or diamond

Loop - The welded steel on the frame for attaching netting

*Begin by identifying the cut selvages on the sides of the net,
and the smooth selvages of the crossbar and most of the bottom.*

Fasten each top corner, Post to Crossbar, of netting to each top corner of goal as located by ①

Fasten each bottom corner, post to base, as located by ③.

From one bottom corner of netting, count selvages to find the middle of netting along base, fasten to center base at ②

From one top corner of netting, count selvages along top to locate center of netting, and fasten at center loop. ④

Lace selvages from point ④ to corner, first one side and then the other ①, carefully maintaining even placement
Now lace each post, beginning at base point ① and down to point ③.

Note: Do not attempt to match each selvage to corresponding loop, fasten selvages for even placement.

Begin lacing base from point ② to ③ adjusting tension by over lacing selvages as desired

You will run out of smooth edge and continue with cut edge

*Alternate method, untrimmed netting, is to center your netting top and bottom to goal,
lacing horizontally from center out one side then the other to get proper tension.
Turn netting at top corner 45 degrees to lace post along square edge of netting*
